




LELAND LEDGE





NATURAL STONE 101: **FULL VS THIN**



DESIGNER'S CHOICE STONE

Natural stone thin veneer is a captivating alternative to full stone

It was developed to give architects, designers, builders and homeowners a choice that expands their creativity.

FULL VENEER

Typically 3" to 5" in depth

Requires a foundation footing Installed with wall ties

Average 35 to 40 square feet per ton coverage

Strong and time-tested method of installation

ADVANTAGES OF THIN STONE

Same high quality stone as full veneer

Typically 3/4" to 11/2" in depth

Similar in weight to artificial stone

Reduced weight allows it to be installed where full veneer cannot or is too difficult

Requires no foundation footing - it's supported by the wall rather than the footing

Average of 135 square feet per ton coverage

Long lasting durability that's based on proven track record over centuries with full veneer

Each piece is different and unique, allowing a creative and custom pattern

Similar in costs to artificial stone - only it's the real thing!

NATURAL FACES OF STONE

SPLITFACE

Stone that has been broken by a hydraulic splitter to a specific size

SEAMFACE

A vertical crack in the quarry that is exposed to the elements, often showing coloration; this is the edge of the stone.

WEATHERED EDGE

This is a natural alteration by either chemical or mechanical processes due to the action of atmospheric conditions, surface waters, soil and other groundwaters, along with temperature changes. This has more of a grooved or textured face.

BEDFACE

The natural top or bottom of a layered stone = a flagstone face. It's also called natural cleft.

GROUTING TECHNIQUES

Throughout our entire brochure our swatches focus on the beauty and color of the stone. We do this because grout, and sometimes the lack of it, has an amazing impact on the look of the final product.

There are three factors that are very important in stone masonry:

- Selecting the right stone for the project
- Selecting a good mason
- Selecting an appropriate grout technique

There are three distinct stone grout techniques that masons can do:

RAKED JOINT

Also known as a standard joint, is achieved by laying each stone roughly one finger width apart from each other, then grouting between each stone. Once the mortar is semi-dry it is later "raked" with a variety of masonry tools to ultimately achieve a consistent depth.

FLUSH JOINT

A flush joint is when a trowel is held flat against the stone or brick and moved along the surface, so as to cut away the excess mortar. The resulting joint is flush with the stone.

OVERGROUT JOINT

The grout overlaps the face of the stone, widening the joints and making them very irregular. This technique tends to give the stone a rustic and aged appearance.

Always have your mason make a mock-up of the grout technique you wish to use prior to beginning the actual installation so you understand how the stone will look on a larger scale.
